AB3032 Free Continuing Education Webinar



AB 3032 requires maternal mental health education for registered nurses and social workers regularly assigned to perinatal units. All general acute care hospitals or special hospitals that have a perinatal unit must develop and implement a program relating to maternal mental health conditions and requires education and information be provided for postpartum women and their families about maternal mental health conditions, post discharge treatment options, and community resources.
