Stina Klemming is a senior consultant neonatologist and the Co-Director for the Lund-Malmö NIDCAP Training and Research Center. She is a NIDCAP Trainer and FINE Trainer and through this she guides health care professionals caring for hospitalized infants and their families. 2018-2021 she was Director of the Karolinska NIDCAP Training and Research Center. Stina is active in the research project IPISTOSS (Immediate Parent Infant Skin-TO-Skin Study) at Karolinska University Hospital. Since 2018 Stina chairs the organizing committee for the Swedish Conference on Ultra-Early Intervention. She is promoting Infant- and Family-Centered Developmental Care (IFCDC) according to NIDCAP on a national and international level. Stina chairs the IFCDC group within the Swedish Neonatal Society, with a formal mandate from the National Health Authorities in Sweden to create national recommendations for Mother-Newborn Couplet Care. In April Stina will have a position as a senior consultant in neonatology at the newest neonatal unit in Sweden opening its' gates April first. This is a unique unit with Mother-Newborn Couplet Care in a common organization around the mother and the baby.
