She also served on the senior executive team of the St. Barnabas Health Care System in New Jersey and led Monmouth Medical Center. Prior to joining Monmouth, she was Vice President of University Hospitals of Cleveland, where she was responsible for Rainbow Babies and Children's Hospital.
